Act 1 Scene 1

- **Four Significant Events with the quotations beneath each event - example:**

1. Capulets and Montagues fight in the street of Verona

“Do you bite your thumb at me, sir?”

- Notice in the above example the quotation marks! IF quotation marks are missing or the quotations are not included with the events, 50% will be deducted.
- This slide will have **ALL 4** events and the quotations that match them underneath them.
- the picture to the right is to be a **SYMBOL** (sword, etc.) and not a picture from any movie or book of Romeo and Juliet. The symbol must represent one of the 4 events. State which event beneath the picture.

Every Act & Every Scene

- Every Act with every Scene will have its own slide. The HEADER of each slide will state which Act AND Scene is on that slide.
- Thus, Act 1, Scene 1 (one slide); Act 1, Scene 2 (one slide), etc.
- Each slide must have 4 significant events and the quotation (in quotation marks) beneath each related event - do NOT write all four events and then all four quotations separated from one another. Follow the example on the previous slide in this presentation.
- Every slide must have 1 symbolic image that represents one of the significant events - state beneath the picture what event it represents. (see the previous slide if you are unsure).
